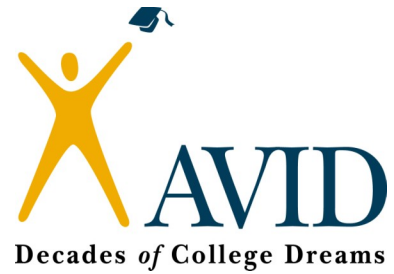


# Be an AVID Tutor

## **What is AVID?**

AVID is an in-school academic support program that prepares 6th through 12th grade students for college eligibility and success. AVID targets students in the academic middle—B and C students—who have the desire to go to college and the willingness to work hard. These are students who are capable of completing a rigorous curriculum with some extra support. AVID supports these students on the college-readiness track. AVID students may be the first in their family to attend college, historically underserved, low income, or have special circumstances.
